The 3rd Pursuit Squadron of the Commemorative Air Force announced a Gala Warbird Fly-in on Saturday, April 16, 2011 from 10am to 2pm at Cable Airport, 1749 W. 13th Street, Upland, CA 91786.

Admission is free to this event which will display and fly numerous, beautifully restored WWII era aircraft for the enjoyment and education of the local citizens.

The 3rd Pursuit Squadron is named in honor of the unit in which their friend and former charter member, Erik Shilling, served in the American Volunteer Group (The Flying Tigers) during the period of WW II. These heroic volunteers flew P-40's in the China theater against the Japanese. This unit is dedicated to memorializing and celebrating the feats of these famous aviators.
